

## WHITE WINES

- Antonio Rubini Pinot Grigio Delle Venezie, Italy – shows apple and pear with hints of white peach and elderflower.
- Cullinan View Sauvignon Blanc, Western Cape, South Africa – attractive Grassy Cape wine laden with crunchy gooseberry crispness.
- Waipara Hills Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand – generous and lifted, showing powerful aromas of nettle and snow pea: the palate bursts with fresh citrus, grapefruit and melon notes.

## ROSÉ WINES

- Parini Pinot Grigio Rosé Delle Venezie, Italy – soft, coppery-pink rosé: delicate and fruity bouquet: soft and fresh on the palate.
- Vendange White Zinfandel, California, USA – a brief time with juice and skin together gives this delicate colour, delicious strawberry aroma and zingy freshness.

## RED WINES

- Cullinan View Shiraz, Western Cape, South Africa – a deep-coloured wine with an excellent Syrah peppery character. The palate is full and generous with rich, velvety tannins and warm toasty-oak on the finish.
- Short Mile Bay Merlot, South-Eastern Australia – soft, light-bodied Merlot with a fruity profile.
- Callia Selected Malbec, San Juan, Argentina – a rich and powerful Malbec that shows a good concentration of blackberry, plum and herbal flavours.

## SPARKLING WINES

- Galanti Prosecco Extra Dry, Italy – fine, persistent, soft fizz surrounds a fruit spectrum of apple, pear with a hint of peach.
- Da Luca Prosecco, Italy – pear and peach fruit on a lively, yet soft and generous palate.
